## Dr. Regula Kyburz-Graber Receives International Environmental Award

Washington, DC – Dr. Regula Kyburz-Graber of the University of Zurich has received an award from the North American Association for Environmental Education (NAAEE) for "Outstanding Contribution to Environmental Education Research." The award is given each year to an individual who has made a significant contribution to environmental education (EE) research. Dr. Kyburz-Graber is the associated dean for resources at the University of Zurich. Dr. Kyburz-Graber has authored numerous articles, presented at many conferences, served as faculty advisor for hundreds of graduate teacher students, and held positions on three editorial boards of journals dedicated to environmental education.

During the past 10 years, she has served on the editorial board of the *Canadian Journal of Environmental Education* as well as *Environmental Education Research*. She has supervised nearly 250 graduate students pursing postgraduate diploma in secondary level II. Recently Dr. Kyburz-Graber served as the organizer and hostess of the 9th Invitational Seminar on Research in Environmental and Health Education on Monte Verità, Ticino, Switzerland.

Dr. Kyburz-Graber attended the NAAEE conference in Virginia Beach, Virginia, USA, on November 17 to accept the award.
